


Alumni's Feedback on Curriculum 2022-23

MIT SoFA is of the opinion that students' feedback would help the teaching faculty in improving their teaching skills and in understanding the requirements of students. This form is part of the Institute's comprehensive approach to curriculum development and consider next steps in learning and overall development.

Form received a total of 34 responses from all 3 departments. Analysis of which is as follows:

- Almost all of the alumni are satisfied with the curriculum offered and admits that the
 course content was rather good (99% rated between Good-Excellent, out of which
 70% Rated it Very Good)
- The career-oriented syllabus and initiatives was quite helpful for them and successfully bridges that gap between academic and industry, thus presenting better opportunities. (91% agree to this)
- The alumni feedback also revealed that the institution supports and create opportunities for higher learning with 100% students rating it between good-excellent
- The curriculum has a positive and balanced academic syllabus and good credit system

 above Very Good)










A] Comparison of feedback of different stakeholders on Rubric Questions (Q.1 TO Q.5)





Pertinent pointers identified & drawn to enhance the learning effectiveness

It is observed from the above analysis that all the stakeholders have rated with very good (35%) and Excellent (32%) in majority. Hence following conclusions are inferred:

Communication Letter of Action Taken for curriculum feedback received from stakeholders for A.Y. 2022-23:

The feedback is taken from the stakeholders (Students, Alumni, Faculty and Employers) and analysed by the committee including feedback coordinators, Academic Coordinator and Dean Faculty of Arts, Fine Arts and Performing Arts. Later, a faculty meeting is organized to incorporate the modification/updation of syllabus with consultation of course teachers. Furthermore, the following observations forwarded to take further action in BoS.

- For the syllabus design and content delivery, all the teachers were notified about the feedback and they were encouraged to enrich the curriculum with more appropriate teaching-learning methods and techniques.
- Concerns expressed for the prescribed time for completion of syllabus have been considered, and conveyed during BOS
- More industry connects and visiting/ adjunct faculty lectures were included as a regular feature in the curriculum
- Industry understanding can be improved by conducting VAP, webinars and training sessions from Industry Experts.
- Formal instructions were circulated to all teachers for addressing the issue of attainment of COs & Pos. Teachers were informed to keep check on the attainment of course outcomes.
- A lot of focus shall be given to interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary courses as per NEP guidelines.
- Some weightage to online certification courses offered by NPTEL can be emphasized for ability enhancement.
