ELIGIBILITY

- BFA (Applied Arts, Painting, Sculpture), 10+2 from any stream or equivalent minimum passing 45% aggregate marks (40% for reserved category) and pass the aptitude test
- MFA (Applied Arts, Painting, Sculpture), Candidate should have passed the under graduation degree in BFA / BVA Applied Arts, Candidate who has completed BFA - Bridge Course from any recognized University / G.D. Applied Art / Painting (10+1+4) can apply with minimum passing 45% aggregate marks (40% for reserved category) and pass the aptitude test
- Ph.D (Fine Arts, Performing Arts), PET conducted by MIT ADT University followed by personal Interview & Presentation, minimum passing 60% (First Class) in Post Graduation of Fine Arts or equivalent degree
